It could be interesting to consider to propose study visit and tours to observe specific childcare services, projects, programs. The teachers will support and accompany women during these group activities.

5. Are the course content contains all relevant subjects needed in the training?

### NOTE

To propose **supplementary and optional modules** (each of about **20 hours**) able to address issues such as:

- Specific pedagogical approaches (Montessori, Steiner, etc.)
- Care and Educational work with children with disabilities
- Follow-up meeting on topics covered by the course, in which women showed deficiencies and need for further information (security, privacy, educational games, practical exercises, etc.)

6. Are the learning methods appropriate to the 50+ women?

### NOTE

The contents and the structure of the training course require considerable capabilities in studying and in understanding the topics addressed.

It is important to consider the necessary prerequisites of women and the studies that they previously carried out.

Therefore, an **initial evaluation of the competences** of the attending women could be proposed:

- **interview** (feedback regarding the curriculum, personal experiences and assessment of interpersonal skills)
- **test** (general skills on the topics of the course, to understand the background and calibrate the lessons)

### 8. Please describe the strengths of the proposed training program

- Defined duration of basic training modules (n. of hour lessons needed to assess professional skills)
- Possibility of modifying the duration of some modules according to local realities and internal laws of each country (e.g. minimum hours required for safety training)



## COURSE MODEL EVALUATION

9. Please describe the weaknesses of the proposed training program

- Module SECURITY: the topic “Mobbing and sexual harassment at work” is not inherent, maybe it's better to talk about "work-related stress“



## COURSE MODEL EVALUATION

10. Please describe other element(s) of the training program that you consider to be a necessity for further development?

- Module COGNITIVE AND AFFECTIVE DEVELOPMENT: 20 hour (instead of 12)
- Module PHYSICAL AND PSYCOMOTOR DEVELOPMENT: 10 hour (instead of 8)
- Module MANAGEMENT OF EDUCATION: 8 hour (missing data)
- INTERSHIP: suggested duration is 30% of the total hours of the course
